

10 DAYS/ 9 NIGHTS TOUR PROPOSAL

Day 1; Arrival

Upon arrival at the Jomo Kenyatta International Airport, you will be met by our representative who will later transfer you to the hotel for check in. Overnight at the Ibis styles Hotel on bed and breakfast.



Day 2-Nairobi-Mt. Kenya (Sweet waters)



After an early breakfast, you will check out from the hotel and depart for Ol pejeta Conservancy. The Ol Pejeta Conservancy is a 90,000-acre (360 km²) not-for-profit wildlife conservancy in Central Kenya's Laikipia County. It is situated on the equator west of Nanyuki, between the foothills of the Aberdares Ranges and Mount Kenya. The Ol Pejeta Conservancy works to conserve wildlife and provide a sanctuary for great apes. The Conservancy boasts the largest black rhino sanctuary in East Africa. Arrive at Sweetwaters tented Camp in time for lunch. Have an afternoon game drive. Dinner and overnight in the camp.

Day 3- Sweet waters to Meru.



In the morning after breakfast depart from Sweetwaters and head towards Meru. You will arrive 3 steers Hotel in time for lunch. Later after lunch you will visit a tea/ coffee factory. Enjoy the rest of the afternoon at leisure. Dinner at 3 steers hotel Meru.

Day 4- Meru to Samburu National Reserve



Depart Meru and drive towards Samburu National Reserve to arrive in time for lunch at **Ashnil Samburu Camp**. This is a game reserve on the banks of the Ewaso Ng'iro River in Kenya. On the other side of the river is the Buffalo Springs National Reserve. At about 1600hours the evening game drive will be conducted then you drive back to your Lodge for dinner and overnight.

Day 5- Samburu National Reserve



Spend this day at the reserve with morning and afternoon game drives. Meals and accommodation at Ashnil Samburu.

Day 6- Nyeri



Depart Samburu and head to Nyeri. Meals and accommodation at Outspan Hotel. The Outspan Hotel Nyeri, located at the heart of Kenyas tea and coffee growing highlands and near the spectacular Karuru Falls is an ideal getaway for any fun loving person. It has great ambience, vibrant gardens and verdant green lawns where peacocks roam at will.

In 1926 Major Eric Sherbrooke Walker and his wife Lady Bettie chose the perfect spot between the Aberdare Mountains and Mount Kenya to build their dream Hotel in Nyeri.

Day 7- Lake Nakuru National Park.

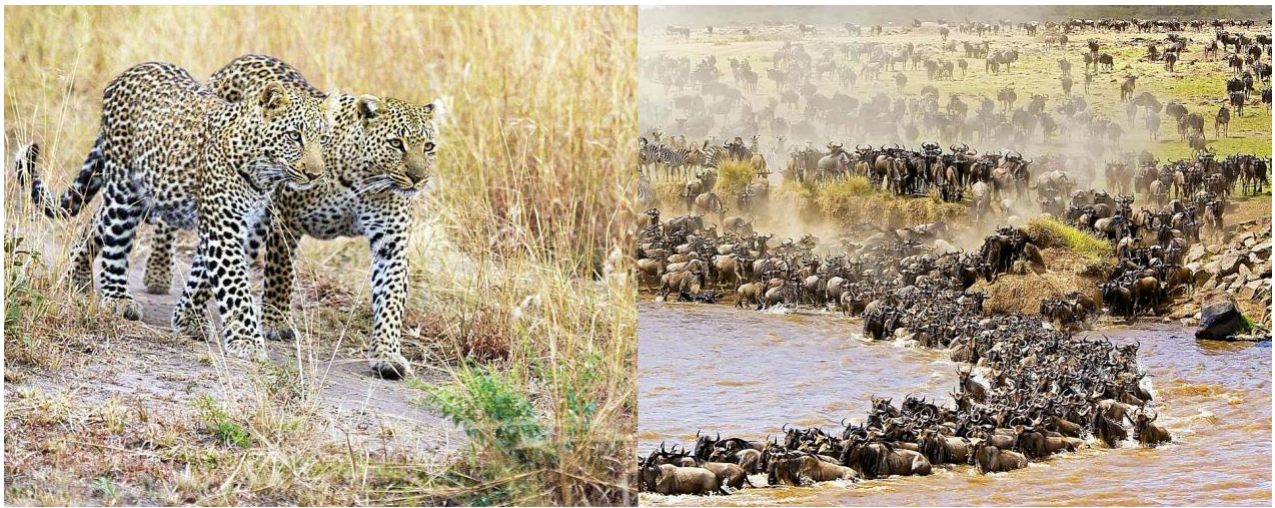
Leave Nyeri and drive towards Nakuru for Nakuru National Park. On the floor of the Great Rift Valley, surrounded by wooded and bushy grassland, lies the beautiful Lake Nakuru National Park also known as Bird Watchers Paradise. Visitors can enjoy the wide ecological diversity and varied habitats that range from Lake Nakuru itself to the surrounding escarpment and picturesque ridges. Lake Nakuru National Park also serves as a rhino Sanctuary. Enjoy a game drive in this beautiful park.



Dinner and overnight will be at **Sarova Lion Hill. (FB)**

Day 8- Masai Mara National Reserve.

Depart Nakuru after breakfast and drive to Masai Mara to arrive Mara Sarova in time for lunch with enroute game drive. The Masai Mara is the extension of Serengeti national Park in Tanzania. It is the most popular game reserve in Eastern Africa. One of the greatest spectacles in the world takes place here from July to October, when wildebeests, antelopes and zebras move from the Serengeti to the Mara and back in October / November. These animals are followed behind by hyenas as they eat the remains of dead animals. There is also the Mara River which is home to hippos and crocodiles.



Later check-into the lodge dinner and overnight. Meals and accommodation at **Mara Sarova.**

Day 9 -Masai Mara



This day will be spent in Masai Mara Game Reserve with Morning and evening game drives. In the Mara you are likely to see the 'big five' among a wide range of wildlife which make up the whole eco system. The reserve has the largest population of cats. The lions are easy to spot and cheetahs are numerous although this predator is elusive. More than 95 species of animals including many bird species have been noted in Masai Mara. By virtue of location and layout,

the Camp offers unparalleled plethora of activities and experiences from luxury tented living to bird-watching, mini golf, sport fishing and a unique insight into the Maasai culture at the adjoining Maasai village. Meals and accommodation will be at **Mara Sarova. (FB)**

Day 10- Depart.

In the morning after breakfast, check out from the camp and depart for Nairobi. Later on proceed to have dinner at Carnivore in Nairobi. After dinner transfer to the airport for your flight back home.
